The Mystery of The Laceyfield Markings

Did your Year 5 pupil ever reach a conclusion about what the mysterious markings which appeared on our school field were? The local press and police even visited school to investigate them but came no closer to finding an answer to our strange anomaly despite the amazing newspaper reports it helped our pupils to generate!

English

As well as our newspaper reports about the Laceyfield mystery markings, year 5 have researched the planets of the solar system and used their knowledge to write non-chronological reports about it. We have written diary entries about visiting alien planets and we have discussed and debated the existence of aliens in order to produce a balanced argument.

Science

Year 5 have covered the key curriculum areas about Earth and Space this term, which include: understanding how the movement of Earth and other planets in relation to the sun; the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth; understanding the Earth and other planets as approximately spherical bodies and how the rotation of the Earth explains day and night, as well as why the sun appears to move through our skies.

<u>Maths</u>

For the Autumn term, we have focussed upon place value, addition & subtraction, multiplication & division and perimeter and area. We have looked at statistics in our project work and used graphs to represent data from scientific investigations into the movement of shadows.

What's coming up?

Next term, Year 5 will exploring The Victorians and asking the question, as a society were they 'Vile or Virtuous'. We hope to arrange a very exciting school trip to support this topic and will be in touch with you as soon as this has been confirmed

In R.E., we have been looking into Hinduism and how Hindus show their commitment to God. We have also been finding out about the Christmas story and the theory and origins behind it.


